EVEN MORE MAJOR ELECTRONIC SKY SIGNS PROPOSED TO CLUTTER ST KILDA JUNCTION

Stonnington Council has received a new planning application for a major electronic promotion sign proposed for the roof of the existing low rise building at 30 Punt Road, Windsor (on the corner of Punt Rd, Albert St and the on-ramp to Queensway). The proposed sign measuring 11m x 3m is heavily oriented towards St Kilda Junction designed to curve around the site's southwest boundary and is proposed to operate 7 days a week 24 hours a day.

If you are concerned about even more unwanted visual clutter and loss of amenity at St Kilda Junction and or the safety issues an ever changing sign will have on traffic then go to our website for more information.
