COUNCIL'S STREET PARKING REVIEW FOR ST KILDA NEIGHBOURHOOD

Port Phillip Council is conducting the St Kilda precinct wide street parking review commencing today. This includes our Junction neighbourhood. You should receive this week from Council a brochure informing you of the detail. ALL PROPOSALS YOU SEE WILL ONLY BE IMPLEMENTED IF THERE IS A MAJORITY SUPPORT DEMONSTRATED BY THE AFFECTED STREET SECTION. IT IS IMPORTANT IF YOU AGREE TO THE CHANGES PROPOSED THAT YOU LET COUNCIL KNOW YOUR FEEDBACK.

Based on the feedback Council receive a second proposal may be introduced. You may like to consider attending one of Council's two drop in information sessions. They will be held on the 23 June from 5pm-7pm at St Kilda RSL, 88 Acland Street, St Kilda and 27 June from 5pm-7pm at Bubup Nairn Family & Children's Centre, 99b Carlisle Street, St Kilda.
