BATTLE TO STOP THE MASSIVE 28 STOREY TOWER AT ST KILDA JUNCTION GOES TO VCAT

Last chance to stop this massive over development at St Kilda Junction that has generated wide community concern as to its height, bulk built form, density and insufficient on-site parking which will further exacerbate lack of street parking in our precinct.

The applicant has now taken this permit application to VCAT for decision.

As residents and business owners we only have until Thursday 7th April, 2016 to lodge our individual objections to VCAT and the various other parties as part of the prescribed process leading up to a June 20th 2016 VCAT hearing.

If you are concerned, like more than 100 fellow residents that this 28 storey high tower development (yes 10 levels higher than the adjacent Lego building),

complete with its 286 apartments, more than 6,000 m2 of retail shops and office space and massive 2 storey high digital advertising sign wrapping around the Nelson Street, Punt Road & Wellington Street facades at the fourth level overlooking St Kilda junction is unacceptable as a reasonable development on our prized JAAG area, then this is your one and only LAST chance to stop it.

You may have been one of over 90 who objected to Council, but to be heard at VCAT you now have to lodge a new objection called a Statement of Grounds to comply and we as residents only have until Thursday 7th April to do this!
