PROPOSED INDUSTRIAL PTV SUBSTATION ON ST. KILDA JUNCTION MEDIAN STRIP

Since the 4 May 2017 meeting of residents called by Public Transport Victoria (PTV) JAAG has been actively working with the Port Phillip Council, and lobbying PTV and politicians, with a view to a solution acceptable to locals.

Under pressure from JAAG and the Council, PTV has investigated a number of potential alternative sites for the substation. However it recently informed JAAG that, for a variety of reasons, none of the alternatives was feasible, and that it will proceed with the construction of a substation at St. Kilda Junction southern central median landscaped area.

PTV has, however, agreed to appoint an architect to design the substation, and both JAAG and the Council have prepared design briefs for PTV to provide to its architect. PTV is currently developing a timetable for the process, including community engagement activities which will hopefully permit the active involvement of residents.
