HAVE YOUR SAY – UPGRADE TO CHIPTON PARK (FORMERLY CRIMEA ST. RESERVE) NEW CONCEPT DESIGN - BE PART OF SHAPING THE PARK'S FUTURE

The very popular Chipton Park, in Crimea Street on the corner with Charnwood Road, has been earmarked by Council for a makeover with new playground equipment and facilities. Council's proposed concept design has just been released, as per the attachment.

We suggest that you consider the proposed design concept and ask yourself whether it responds to expectations of a modern friendly design with state of the art children's play equipment in a cool green oasis that is a user-friendly inner-city space that encourages people to interact. Are there design aspects missing (for instance shade over children's play area, safety fence for children, safety issues, sustainable equipment and others). If we want to make a difference to this pocket park we strongly suggest you participate in providing your feedback to Council.
