

MICRO NEWS UPDATE – 29 October 2019

**“HAVE YOUR SAY”
ON COUNCIL’S DRAFT PARKING
MANAGEMENT POLICY**

As you would be aware from our 13th October Micro News, Council’s draft parking policy is out for comment. Changes proposed significantly alter both the residential parking permit and visitor permit schemes. They include:

- Abolishing the ‘surrounding streets’ rule for residential permits, replacing it with an entitlement to park anywhere in ‘area 9’, that is between Dandenong Road, St.Kilda Road, Inkerman Street and Chapel Street.
- Reducing the number of parking permits a property with on-site parking reached directly from a street i.e. a crossover can have. In some cases there will be no entitlement.
- Abolishing annual visitor parking permits, replacing them with a single use voucher system. The details of how the voucher system will work have not been explained and it seems capable of abuse.
- Abolishing foreshore permits and replacing them with a voucher system.

Rules denying permits for apartments built after 1 October 2002 will continue to apply.
