New sporting pavilion at

Albert Park

Works have commenced on new sporting pavilion at Oval One in February 2022

In partnership with Sport and Recreation Victoria, we're delivering an exciting new shared-use sporting pavilion at Oval One in Albert Park.

Project progress

Since our last update in November 2021 we have completed the technical design of the pavilion and worked with the Sports User Advisory group to ensure the features on the inside of the pavilion will meet all users' needs.

Construction has commenced

Works have commenced on site at Albert Park for the new pavilion in **February 2022**.

While a construction site will be established in the north-east corner of Oval One, access to the oval will be maintained throughout construction.

There may occasionally be times where there is some restricted path access near the construction site. Signed detours will be put in place during days with these conditions.

We've opted for a pre-fabricated modular pavilion design. This means most of the construction will take place off site, resulting in a shorter on-site construction period, less disruption for park users and a smaller footprint from the new pavilion.

Project background

Oval One is one of many busy sporting fields at Albert Park but doesn't currently have toilets or change room facilities to support the diverse needs of the sporting groups that play or practice at the oval.

The new sporting pavilion will provide greater access for local sporting clubs and more opportunities for people to participate in community sport. It will help meet the growing demand and changing needs of the local community, including increased female sport participation.

Project timeline

- **August 2021:** Contract awarded for design and construct
- **August – January 2021:** Detailed design period
- **February 2022:** Pavilion construction and installation commenced
- **Mid-2022:** Construction complete
